Healing On The Streets

Last year we were asked by our friends at Aylesbury Vineyard if we would consider becoming the 'umbrella' organisation to take over



the leadership and oversight of Healing On The Streets in Aylesbury. After prayer and discussion, the trustees agreed; this is another 'out there', cross-church ministry and is appreciated and supported by our existing partners in the Town Centre Manager's office (and it's a similar setup in Luton Town Centre Chaplaincy). The day-to-day operation of this work will remain as is, with Sue Fox a wonderful team leader/co-ordinator for the H.O.T.S. team. The team will be out once a month as usual; next time Saturday 4th February 2017.
