3. Internet café – helping people to access information, friends and family
4. Listening café – with trained listeners ready to listen
5. Help café – signposting people to local specialist help available
6. In-Stitches café – Pauline Latham's existing group
7. Other, as yet, unknown activities

Please note that these are all working titles and can be changed to something better.
