We are continuing to hold volunteer update meetings fortnightly on zoom where we have the opportunity to catch up and pray for one another, as well as holding regular meetings with individual volunteers in person now, or via zoom.

Latest news

From 1st May 2020 our part-time staff have taken a reduced salary to reflect the reduction in some aspects of their work during this time.

Our first 'in-person' talk to a group was held in September. Mark was welcomed to the Aston Clinton Ladies' Group to speak about the Chaplaincy. He had a great welcome, and all there were really interested to hear about what we do.

Mark chaired the first 'in-person' IAG meeting for over 12 months. The Independent Advisory Groups are a way of the local police forces working with the diverse communities they serve – gain trust, work co-operatively, and for local communities concerns to be heard and addressed.
