Dear All,

This Sunday, 27 July, the focus of our Circuit Prayers is on our Circuit Leadership Team. People often wonder what this mysterious body does, and I think the best answer is that it keeps the wheels of our circuit oiled and turning. So, what is a Leadership team?

In Acts 6 we read the following: In those days when the disciples were increasing in number, the Grecian Jews among them began to grumble against the Hebraic Jews because their widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food. So the Twelve summoned all the disciples and said, "It is unacceptable for us to neglect the word of God in order to wait on tables.

Therefore, brothers, select from among you seven men confirmed to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will assign this responsibility to them and will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word."

The Jerusalem Church founded the very first Christian Circuit Leadership Team! The writer of Acts then goes on to say: *This proposal pleased the whole group!*

The early church needed a dedicated group of people to ensure that the organisation ran smoothly and any problems that arose were swiftly and lovingly dealt with.

The Leadership Team enables our ministers to minister, our preachers to preach, and our churches to reach out into the community with the love of Christ.

Our Circuit Leadership Team still operates with the same high standards to ensure that the work of Christ is carried out as honestly and faithfully today as it was two millennia ago.

But there are major differences between the way our CLT arrives at any necessary decisions and the way in which similar bodies outside the church would answer the same problems.

Being a registered charity, we have to be very careful to ensure that any financial decisions we make are within the charity laws, and always strive to achieve the best return on money that has been given to the church; but alongside that requirement, I feel, is the need to always ensure that we behave exactly as Jesus would if he was making the decision.

We are blessed with having a vast array of talent within our CLT, but all have one thing in common: a calling to offer the love of Christ in each and every situation and to ensure that common sense and Christian love go hand in hand.

What a Team!

Please pray for our Circuit Leadership Team this week, that they may continue to enable the work of Christ in our Circuit and share in the knowledge and joy of his love. Pete.
