All children MUST be accompanied by an ADULT.



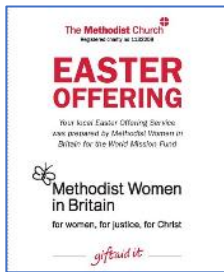
A service of thanksgiving for the life of Paul Thomas will take place on 23rd April, 12.30pm at Stewkley.
