<u>Item</u>	<u>Description</u>
Reflective Radiator Panels	Prevents loss of heat through outer wall
Chimney Balloon	A balloon for unused chimney
Cylinder jackets	Helps maintain hot water
Electricity consumption monitors	You can see how much you are using
Smart Plugs	Remotely access your
Shower heads	for combi boiler systems - NOT power shower
Door brush draft excluder	Seal gaps under front door
Wireless Home Energy Monitor	Monitor how much you use and cost
Glazing film	
V-seal tape	
Letter Box	To save energy
LED bulbs (non-bayonet)	
Thermocard	Checks the temperature of shower/bath water
Shower Timer	Times your shower
WC displacement bag	Cuts down on water cistern use
